NURSES ATTEND IMMUNIZATION CONFERENCE

RDHU nurses attended the annual ND Immunization Conference to explore strategies and best practices to increase immunization coverage rates, learn communication skills for responding to questions from patients/families, and to learn the latest updates to immunization schedules. While at the conference, counties were recognized for their high achievement of immunization rates.

- LRDHU—Benson County was awarded the 'Adolescent HPV Immunization Award' for achieving 80% or greater vaccine rate
- LRDHU—Eddy County was awarded the 'Adult Zoster Immunization Award' for achieving a rate of 65% or greater
- LRDHU—Pierce County was awarded the 'Adolescent Meningococcal Immunization Award' for achieving a rate of 100%

NDTip is an anonymous, easy-to-use app that is designed to protect people from unsafe situations.

You can download the NDTip app from the App Store or Google Play and submit anonymous tips about suspicious activity to your county Sheriff's Department.

BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

October is Breast Cancer Awareness month. About one in eight North Dakota women will get breast cancer during their lifetime. For those who are diagnosed, early detection greatly increase the chances of survival.

1 in 17 North Dakota women may be eligible for free Breast and Cervical Cancer Screenings through *Women's Way*.

Eligibility requirements include:

- Live in North Dakota
- Are ages 40 through 64
- Are ages 21 through 39, have breast symptoms (lump) or at high risk for breast cancer, are due for a Pap test, or need breast or cervical diagnostic procedures
- Have insurance that doesn't cover Pap test and/or mammograms or cannot afford to pay their deductible and/or co-payments or does not have insurance
- Meet income guidelines

BREASTFEEDING MONTH

A ugust is National Breastfeeding Month. WIC provides breastfeeding information, support, and assistance. In addition, WIC offers a positive clinic environment that supports breastfeeding. WIC mothers are encouraged to breastfeed their infants, unless medically contraindicated.

- WIC mothers choosing to breastfeed are provided information through counseling, support groups, and breastfeeding educational materials.
- Breastfeeding mothers receive follow-up support through breastfeeding peer counselors.
- Breastfeeding mothers are eligible to participate in WIC longer than non-breastfeeding mothers.
- Breastfeeding mothers can receive breast pumps and other supplies to help with the initiation and continuation of breastfeeding.
- Mothers who exclusively breastfeed their infants receive an enhanced food package.
